

FNSR Security Update – Multi Factor Authentication

What is changing?

Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) will now be required to sign in to FNSR. Users must download the Microsoft Authenticator app on their mobile device and scan a QR code to set up their account and use one-time passcodes.

Authentication in FNSR

Step 1: After signing in, the user will be prompted to scan the QR code using the Microsoft Authenticator app.

Two-Factor Authentication.

Select Two-Factor Authentication Provider:

Step 2: After scanning the QR code, the user will see the FNSR account appear in the Microsoft Authenticator app. They can then use the one-time passcode and click the Verify & Enable button.

Two-Factor Authentication.

Setup FNSR in your Authenticator App

Scan this QR code in your Microsoft Authenticator app:

Enter code from app to confirm:

Step 3: The user will be asked to enter the code one more time. After setup, future login attempts will allow the user to authenticate through the Microsoft Authenticator app.
